Dr. Greaney founded Greaney Medical Group, an occupational healthcare facility in Anaheim, California, in 1984 and simultaneously developed a medical consulting practice, which is now separately organized as WorkCare™. He provides consultation to private companies, public agencies, insurance carriers and the legal profession on toxic, environmental and other occupational induced injuries/illnesses. He has retainers to serve as medical director for over 20 different national companies, including chemical, oil and gas, manufacturing, engineering, geotechnical and hazardous material. He has established medical surveillance and OSHA compliance programs for over 200 employers and has established post-offer medical standards for a variety of state, county, and local governments, including making recommendations for effective employee health programs. He has acted as an expert witness and Agreed Medical Examiner in complex workers' compensation and toxic tort cases. His accomplishments and experience include:
